OPEN CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

City Hall – 105 E. Ohio Street, Clinton, MO 64735 Tuesday, April 6, 2021 • 6:00 p.m.

The City Council of the City of Clinton, Missouri met on Tuesday, April 6, 2021. President Pro Tem Wilson presided.

1. Call to Order: President Pro Tem Wilson called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

2. Roll Call:

<u>Council Persons Present</u>: Gene Henry, Cameron Jackson, Carla Moberly, Rick Pereles, Becky Raysik, Ken Scott, Debbie Smith and Daniel Wilson

Others Present: City Administrator Christy Maggi, City Attorney Doug Harris, City Clerk Wendee Seaton, Fire Chief Mark Manuel

- 3. Pledge of Allegiance: Was recited.
- 4. **Approval of Minutes:** Council Person Jackson made a motion to approve the minutes of the Open City Council Meeting of March 16, 2021. Council Person Smith duly seconded the motion. 8 Ayes; 0 Nays. President Pro Tem Wilson declared the motion passed.

5. Personal Appearances:

a. Clint Lam spoke on the passing of J.C. Smith and asked for a moment of silence. A moment of silence was observed.

6. Reports:

- a. Wallace White Clinton Regional Airport Report: The Airport Board met to discuss the apron bids. He is working with Garver and MoDOT on this project. There has been an increase in local traffic and the National Guard has been using the airport frequently. He is looking at 1-2 possible interns this summer. Working with the Economic Development Director on a project. He appreciates Christy Maggi's hard work and dedication on the apron project.
- b. Mark Dawson Economic Development Report: Current unemployment rate is 5.2%. There will be a five-county employment survey of local manufacturers to give an idea on how Henry County compares to other counties. Five new projects have been opened with a total of 18 currently in the works. One project selected a neighboring town due to the lack of 3,000-5,000 sq. ft. buildings in Clinton.

- b. Lower Level Pump #1 replacement recommendation: Dan reviewed the AWR recommendation to replace Pump # 1. The support documents for the price quotes will be forwarded to Public Works Committee prior to council. Council Person Jackson made a motion to approve Alliance Water Resources Option #4 for full replacement not to exceed \$64,945. Council Person Henry duly seconded the motion. 8 Ayes; O Nays. President Pro Tem Wilson declared the motion passed.

- 2. Park & Recreation Program Evaluation: Discussed the purpose of the info and ways in which to improve the report. For information only.

3. Englewood Cemetery:

Council Person Jackson duly seconded the motion. 8 Ayes; 0 Nays. President Pro Tem Wilson declared the motion passed. The City will send this announcement out to the media.

A signed deed restriction requiring the property owner to pay for future curb and gutter improvements will be required, prior to holding the second reading of the bill. Discussion was held on the location of the driveway. The current indication is that the driveway will be on Vansant Road.

President Pro Tem Wilson called for the first reading by title only of Bill No. 2021-02.

- 2. Airport Apron Bids: Phases 2 and 3: Discussion on doing both phases together and the additional cost of approximately \$175,000 and a 3-5 year delay by postponing Phase 3. The Airport Board voted unanimously to recommend doing both phases now. The City has the funding for all of Phase 2 and can apply for additional funding to cover the Phase 3 cost of \$156,377.04. Council Person Pereles made a motion to approve the bid from Phillips Hardy in the amount of \$759,167.35 for Phase 2 and 3 of the Airport Apron Project. Council Person Scott duly seconded the motion. 8 Ayes; 9 Nays. President Pro Tem Wilson declared the motion passed.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF LAND WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to RSMo 71.012, Mauricio Tormen did request that certain land be annexed within the Corporate limits of the City of Clinton; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton Planning Commission did hold a public hearing on April 5, 2021, which was not less than fourteen (14) days nor more than sixty (60) days after receipt of the petition, and after providing for notice of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation authorized to publish legal notices; and

WHEREAS, the Clinton Planning Commission did, on April 5, 2021, recommend approval of the annexation request, with the property to be zoned R-1 Single Family Residential, by a vote of 4 Ayes, 0 Nays and 3 Absent; and

WHEREAS, all statutory requirements have been met;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Clinton, Missouri as follows:

Section 1: The City Council of Clinton, Missouri determines that the annexation requested is reasonable and necessary to the proper development of the City and the City has the ability to furnish normal municipal services to the area within a reasonable time.

Section 2: The City of Clinton hereby annexes into the corporate limits of the City of Clinton the property commonly known as 1302 North Vansant Road, which is legally described as follows:

Lot Eight (8), Prairie View Estates, a subdivision in Henry County, Missouri. Subject to easements, restrictions and reservations of record, if any.

Section 3: The City of Clinton hereby accepts a Deed Restriction, pertaining to future street and curb/ gutter improvements, recording said document as an encumbrance on the current property owners and all future owners of the property.

Section 4: The property shall be zoned R-1 Single Family Residential.

Section 5: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED by Mauricio Tormen, as follows:


1. Mauricio Tormen hereby agrees to place this restrictive covenant to run with the land and specifically upon the following-described real estate:


Englewood Cemetery, Block 517
